Kingswood Parish Council (KPC) operations during the Coronavirus - KPC is operating normally and meeting via publicly accessible conference meetings on the second Monday of the month. Full details of meetings will be advertised on the KPC website and social media pages with details of how the public can join the meeting. The legislation to allow meeting via Zoom ends on the 7^{th of} May 2021. Due to the parish council elections the May meeting will take place on 17th May 2021 the location will be advised on the agenda and on the KPC website.

Playing field and Play Equipment – The playing field and the play equipment remain open subject to Covid 19 legislation. Please keep your distance from others and use the hand sanitiser provided. Please report any concerns to the clerk. Work will take place to install the new fence around the play equipment in April.

Tyndale View - KPC will be installing bollards around the grass area by the play equipment to ensure the safety of pedestrians using this area. Work will take place in April 2021.

Parish Council Elections 6th May 2021 - The parish Council elections are scheduled to take place on Thursday 6th May. The term of office is for 4 years. The number of councillors for KPC has been increased to 8. Please see the Stroud District Council's (SDC) website for more details on the process. Nomination papers are now available and can be received from SDC or from the Clerk to KPC. The completed papers can be returned by making an appointment to take the papers in person to SDC offices at Ebley Mill between the 23rd March and 8th April between 9am and 5pm. All completed papers must be with SDC by 4pm 8th April. Alternatively, you can meet with the Clerk to KPC at Kingswood Village Hall between 5pm and 7.30pm on Tuesday 30th March. SDC is carrying out a briefing session via Zoom on 13th April. Please email elections@stroud.gov.uk and a link to this meeting will be sent to you.

Kingswood ANPR Cameras - Our two ANPR cameras continue to record high numbers of vehicles exceeding the 30mph speed limit. The count for the two is now 41661 since the 1st of January and 12161 since 1st March and including 6 at 52 mph, 8788 travelling away from the village. Please be mindful of your speed. The parish council still hopes to install two additional cameras, on Hillesley and Wotton Roads, but the County Council is currently withholding permission.
