THE KEEPERS IN KINGSWOOD

Since the Grapevine entry earlier in the year calling for volunteers to help form a new group to continue the KVA-led volunteering effort to support to the people of Kingswood throughout the Coronavirus epidemic, a new group has formed and been working on a proposal to set up a new Community Hub in Kingswood, in co-operation with The Keepers, Wotton Area Community Hub. A Keepers in Kingswood has the potential to reach and connect more easily with local people and provide activities and access to services directed at the specific needs of the village. Furthermore, "Churches Together In Kingswood" have also engaged with The Keepers and recognised the benefits of working together. As a result, the Churches have agreed to make Lower School Room and St Mary's Room available as a base. Following the model established by the Keepers, the next thing to do, is find out what the needs of the community are, and who would like to help and support a community hub in the village. We have therefore produced a survey which we hope you will complete to help us work out what people can offer and the needs that exist. During the recent exceptionally hot and dry weather the ponds at the wildlife area have completely dried up. This created an opportunity for volunteers, under the guidance of Richard from Stroud Valleys Project, to get into the newt pond and remove as much of the invasive New Zealand pigmyweed as we could. The weed will be left around the banks of the pond for a couple of weeks and then composted at the site. Highways - All four ANPR cameras are now working and are helping to reduce speeding in Kingswood. In the month of July there were 12 vehicles travelling at over 60mph in a 30mph limit. The details of these vehicles have been passed to the Police for action. In addition to the above, in July and the first part of August the Police have made contact with over 132 drivers who were monitored as speeding. In August the Wotton Road camera was once again installed and sadly is recording a high number of vehicles speeding. We are currently in discussion with the Police on this issue. In particular what action the Police will take on those drivers who think it is acceptable to drive at high speed through the village, endangering other vehicles and pedestrians. In September the Highways team will be carrying out a Highway Safety Assessment on the speed of vehicles on Wotton Road, on the effectiveness of the Wotton Road priority junction and the parking on the Chipping. We will report back once we have received the report on what the solutions to the issues raised are.

School buses – South Gloucestershire Council has agreed that the following buses will no longer come through the village of Kingswood - **911**, **912 & 914**. Please can you let The Clerk know if you see these buses on Charfield Road so that it can be reported to South Gloucestershire Council. Your help on this will be much appreciated. This should help with the congestion and make it a little safer for children going to school.

KLB drop off and pick up – Please can we ask that parents use the drop off facilities at KLB school and not park on the pavement or on the yellow zigzag lines outside of the school.

Anti-Social Behaviour - Can all cases of anti-social behaviour be reported to the Police at the time of the incident. It is only that way that action will be taken, and a Police presence allocated to Kingswood as there will be a record of the incidences. **Toilets in the Playing field –** The building of the new toilets should commence September / October. We look forward to them being opened in the new year.
