Every year the newt population at the wildlife area in Kingswood is surveyed to see how they are doing. Three surveys are carried out over the month of May when the newts are in the ponds to breed. Members of the public are invited to come along on **Saturday 11th May from 7.45am** as we release and count the newts. Traps are set in the ponds on the Friday evening and over night the newts swim into the traps and we release them back into the pond the following morning. This is a wonderful opportunity to get a good look at the Smooth, Great Crested and Palmate newts that live in the Wildlife area.
